

2009-2014 TAX REVIEW COMPLETED FROM SQM S.A. AFFILIATES

Santiago, Chile. April 24, 2015.- Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile S.A. (SQM) (NYSE: SQM; Santiago Stock Exchange: SQM-B, SQM-A) informed today that Patricio de Solminihac, CEO of the Company, during the Annual General Shareholder meeting held today stated that SQM has completed a review of its different affiliates from 2009-2014. This review was done to verify if expenses incurred during that time period had sufficient supporting documentation to be qualified as tax expenses under the Chilean tax code. It is important to note that invoices were issued for these expenses, and the review is related to supporting documentation.

The Company has identified expenses without proper supporting documentation only related to its affiliate SQM Salar. The amount associated with SQM Salar is significantly less, under 17% of the amount identified for SQM S.A., which was amended a few weeks ago with the Chilean Internal Revenue Service (known as the Servicio de Impuestos Internos or the "SII").

The same methodology used for the amended tax filing of SQM S.A. was also used to analyze its affiliates. The Company cannot rule out that it is making amendments for expenses that were indeed necessary to generate income. SQM S.A and SQM Salar will send to the public prosecutor any supporting documentation necessary related to the expenses. Upon completion of reviews by the SII, SQM and SQM Salar could be entitled to tax reimbursement for taxes paid in excess related to the amended tax filings.

SQM reaffirms its decision to continuing supporting the efforts of the SII and Public Prosecutor, providing all of the information necessary to resolve the issues currently under investigation.
